

**General Remark: For the shipments of HHGS and personal effects between countries in European Union there are no customs formalities, starting with 2007, January 1st.**

This import is possible starting with the date from the Resident Permit but not more than 12 months after.</p> <p>Any person older than 15 years, who travels to Romania, is allowed to bring in exemption of duties and taxes goods with a value assessed by the customs, according to their tariffs for used personal effects, in amount of 175 EURO. For younger person this amount is 90 EURO. For what exceeds this value, duties and taxes are to be paid according to Customs Import Tariffs of Romania.</p> <p>Still, there are possibilities to import in Romania used personal effects in exemption of duties and taxes when a person with residence abroad who comes to work in Romania</p>	<p>Documents needed for importing a car: original registration card, sale certificate or invoice in original.</p> <p>Cars can be registered only if they comply with EUR 3 standard. Diplomatic cars are not affected by this regulation.</p>

This facility is granted for one residence and a single transport, only. <b>THEREFORE, THE CUSTOMS OFFICER WILL WRITE IN THE ORIGINAL PASSPORT OF THE CLIENT THE REGISTRATION NUMBER OF THE APPROVAL.</b></p>	<p>No vehicules, motorcycles, small plains, small boats can be included in the shipment.</p>

(provided by the origin agent)</li> <li>- Copy of Passport showing custom stamps for entry in Romania</li> <li>- Attestation from Romanian School / University that the client follows day-time classes</li> <li>- Legalized statement of the client that the goods in the shipment belong to him, that are not meant for commercial purposes but to furnish the residence (template provided by the moving company, in Romania).</li> <li>- Proof of Romanian residence.</li> <li>- Legalized mandate for the moving company, to perform customs clearance (provided by the client, in Romania)</li> </ul>	<p>If all these documents are available, the client will have a temporary import in exemption of duties and taxes for the goods needed to furnish a scholar residence (usual exclusions: alcohol, stupefians, fire guns, cigars and cigarettes...).</p>	<p>No vehicules, motorcycles, small plains, small boats can be included in the shipment.</p>

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<p><b>Returning Romanian citizens (which previously have gave up Romanian ID)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Original repatriation forms from Internal Affair Ministry / Police (the client apply to Ministry of Internal Affairs);</li> <li>- Packing List in English or Romanian (provided by the origin agent)</li> <li>- Valued Inventory List in English or Romanian, showing serial numbers of electric appliances (provided by the origin agent)</li> <li>- Copy of Passport and Romanian ID.</li> <li>- Legalized statement of the client that the goods in the shipment belong to him for at least 6 months, that are not meant for commercial purposes but to furnish his residence (template provided by the moving company, in Romania).</li> <li>- Legalized mandate for the moving company, to perform customs clearance (provided by the client, in Romania)</li> </ul>	<p>If all these documents are available, the client will have an import in exemption of duties and taxes for anything (usual exclusions: alcohol, stupefians, fire guns, cigars and cigarettes...) including vehicles, motorcycles, small plains, small boats for personal use. 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<p><b>Returning Romanian citizen, with valid Romanian ID</b></p>	<p>Resident Permit in origin country is requested, in order to prove that he lived abroad at least 1 year. This can be replaced by certificate of changing the residence from Romanian Embassy in that country OR lease contract for the residence abroad + copy of payment rolls for last 12 months            Original attestation from employer abroad that he worked there for at least one year            - Valued Inventory List in English or Romanian, showing serial numbers of electric appliances (provided by the origin agent)            - Copy of Passport and Romanian ID.            - Legalized statement of the client that the goods in the shipment belong to him for at least 6 months, that are not meant for commercial purposes but to furnish his residence (template provided by the moving company, in Romania).            - Legalized mandate for the moving company, to perform customs clearance (provided by the client, in Romania)</p>	<p>If all these documents are available, the client will have an import in exemption of duties and taxes for anything (usual exclusions: alcohol, stupefians, fire guns, cigars and cigarettes...) including vehicles, motorcycles, small plains, small boats for personal use. <b>Goods inherited by a person with residence in Romania</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Original legacy certificate translated in Romanian, in which all items are mentioned and described.</li> <li>- Packing List in English or Romanian (provided by the origin agent)</li> <li>- Valued Inventory List in English or Romanian, showing serial numbers of electric appliances (provided by the origin agent)</li> <li>- Copy of Passport and Romanian ID.</li> <li>- Legalized mandate for the moving company, to perform customs clearance (provided by the client, in Romania)</li> </ul>	<p>If all these documents are available, the client will have an import in exemption of duties and taxes for anything (usual exclusions: alcohol, stupefians, fire guns, cigars and cigarettes...) including vehicles, motorcycles, small plains, small boats for personal use. This import is possible starting with the date from the legacy certificate but not more than 2 years after. Several imports are allowed during these 2 years but all goods should be mentioned on the same legacy certificate.</p>	
<b>Alcohol and cigars</b>	Only as part of HHGS shipment	can be imported only 1 l over 220 or 2 l of 220 , 2 l of wine, 200 cigarettes or 50 cigars or 250 g tobacco.	
<b>Works of Art, Antiques, Musical instruments, chinaware, cristalware, rugs</b>	2 photos of each.	Importation allowed.	
<b>Old books</b>	Detailed list of contents (titles, authors and year of issue).		
<b>Precious metal objects (jewellery, gold ware, silverware)</b>	2 photos of each.	Importation restricted except quantities for personal use.	
<b>Firearms, ammunition, explosives, fireworks</b>		Firearms, ammunitions are submitted to authorization from territorial administration.

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<b>Vehicles</b>	<p><b>NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO TEMPORARY IMPORTATION (expats):</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- property title</li> <li>- registration certificate under the name of the client</li> <li>- valid plates</li> </ul> <p><b>NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO DEFINITIVE IMPORTATION (returning Romanians):</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- original legalized translation in Romanian of car's identity card (carte de identitate)</li> <li>- copy of car's identity card in the language was issued</li> <li>- original translation in Romanian of invoice</li> <li>- copy of invoice in language was issued</li> <li>- copy of mandatory insurance for traffic (asigurare obligatorie)</li> <li>- original certificate from RAR for the customs (nota constatare RAR pentru vama)</li> </ul>	<p>Starting with 2007, January 1st new fiscal regulations and charges for registration of second hand car will be implemented. To register a car in Romania (if complies at least with EURO 3 standards, otherwise is not possible) owner will have to pay ecological charge. This depends of age, engine capacity and type of fuel. <p><b>Remarks</b></p>	<p>In Romania you can register any car with the payment of first registration charge which may vary from few hundreds EURO (if your car complies with EURO 4 standards) to thousands of EURO (if is non EURO or EURO 1). 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			<p>If you will have a diplomatic status in Romania, all these regulations don't apply. Under diplomatic plates no first registration charge will apply.</p> <p>If you are returning Romanian citizen, please be aware that further investigations have to be performed by RAR. For this your car has to be presented to RAR. We have to unload it from container / truck, in bonded storage and you to arrange with a platform for trucking from customs office to RAR. You also have to take an appointment at RAR (see phone no above) in order to get the customs certificate. Only the owner of the car is entitled to be there. There will be charges related to bonded storage of the car, trucking of the car from customs office to RAR, and RAR fees for customs certificate.</p> <p>If you are an expat, please be aware that you cannot <b>register or import</b> the car without Romanian temporary ID (also called Resident Permit). Car should be in your possession 6 months before shipping it to Romania.</p> <p>If you are a returning Romanian citizen, the car should be in your possession (date of invoice) for at least 6 months at the moment of getting repatriations forms (date written of the documents as the date you have gained back your Romanian residence).</p> <p>Duties &amp; taxes for vehicles:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- customs duties (% from purchasing value in the invoice; this percentage depends on country, for USA is 10%) - cd</li> <li>- customs commission (0,5 % from customs values) – cc</li> <li>- VAT 19 % from customs value + customs duties + customs commission</li> </ul> <p>For the vehicles with EUR 1 certificate, customs duties and customs commission is 0%. Remain only VAT. EUR1 is issued by the manufacturer and confirmed by customs at export, if the car is produced in European Union.</p>
