<p>As from 01-05-2009 all containers arriving in the Port of Rotterdam with a too high concentration of gas, will be taken out from the logistic transport chain. (Methylbromide is mostly used toxic gas)</p> <p>According to the Ministry one may expect delays running up to several months before a fumigated container finally will be released to the consignee. Obviously high costs will be involved if a container has a too high concentration of gas.</p> <p>We strongly suggest that you also urge all members world wide (mainly Asia, Africa and South America) to reduce or preferably stop fumigating containers. Do consider the massive impact and consequences this will have on your / our customers!</p>			
<p>Removal goods</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Exemption of duties form issued by the Customs Authorities <p>To apply for this import license, the following documents are required:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Application form duly signed "Aanvraag vrijstelling" • Clear copy of the shipper's passport • Copy of the shipper's housing contract in the Netherlands (rental or purchase) • Copy of the work contract or statement of employer in the Netherlands (with length of employment and position in the firm) • Copy of the registration at town/city hall where the shipper will live (this document has to mention the country the shipper is moving from) • Inventory in 2 copies. <p>See details under "Remark"</p>	<p>Duty free entry, provided removal goods:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have been since 6 months the property of the applicant. • Are appropriate to the social position of the applicant. • Have not been acquired for the purpose of duty free import. • Show trace of use. • Will remain the applicant's property at least for 12 months. 	<p><i>Important:</i></p> <p>The time needed to obtain the required original licence could take 1 up to 2 weeks. The request can be made only if all the required listed documents are available. Upon receipt of the original exemption form by the remover, the customs clearance itself will take another 1 or 2 working days. The total process time will be about 2 to 3 weeks and is totally dependable on the Customs and the municipality where the customer will be registered.</p>
